

## SERVICE ANIMALS – Utah Code 62A-5b

**Requirements** – Any dog that is individually trained to work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability. An animal’s presence for emotional support, well-being, comfort, or companionship does not constitute a service animal under this definition.

### **Procedures - prior to the start of school, if possible**
